What is Namibia2Germany?

The Namibia2Germany programme aims to promote the German dual vocational training system as an attractive educational opportunity for young German-speaking Namibians.

During the 1-year coaching and mentoring programme, starting in July 2024, participants receive personal career guidance, interact with our German partner companies who offer 'Ausbildung' programmes in various industries, and receive assistance and guidance throughout the application and preparation process for their 'Ausbildung'. The programme is offered virtually, with 1-2 optional inperson workshops in Windhoek.

Participants who have successfully applied for their 'Ausbildung' will receive support with their visa application, practical and cultural training prior to their departure to Germany, and additional mentoring after the start of their 'Ausbildung'

Application Requirements

Applicants should meet the following criteria:

- German language proficiency (B1 or higher)
- Minimum age: 18 years at the time of application
- Completed grade 11 (or higher)
- Stable and regular internet access
- · Resident and/or citizen of Namibia

Applications for the 2024/25 programme cycle will be open from **1 February to 30 April 2024**!
